## **SECTION 5 GAMES 2016 ADMINISTRATION**

- 1. Region Registration Have each player print off their MY2015 Player Form by:
  - 1. Login into www.eayso.org
  - 2. Select "Print player's application"
  - 3. Select players name.
  - 4. Select the printer icon at the top of the form.
  - 5. Print a copy Player Form (all three pages).

Coach collects Player Forms and a cheque (no cash) for \$125 – cheque made payable to "AYSO Region 498". Contact registrar (registrar@ayso498.org) to arrange hand over of forms and cheques.

Once Registered players will be entered in eAYSO and assigned to their team by the Coordinator. Coordinator will send coaches their official roster.

- 2. **S5G Registration** Once coaches have their Team Roster they will need to register their team for the S5G Tournament at <a href="https://www.soccerincollege.com/TTApply0.aspx?tid=SECTION5&tab=3&sub=0">https://www.soccerincollege.com/TTApply0.aspx?tid=SECTION5&tab=3&sub=0</a>. Coaches will be required to create an account, if they don't already have one. Follow the instructions to Add a New Team. The team name MUST be in the format "R498-UXXG-TeamName"; where XX is the age division and G is the gender. For example, R498-U12B-Raptors. **Any fees will be paid from the Region account, do not make an online payment**. The Coordinator will arrange for the fees for all Region 498 teams.
- 3. **Uniforms** The Region 498 S5G uniform will be a 2/2/2 set (i.e. 2 shirts, 2 shorts, 2 pair socks) of Italy 550/118 shorts/828 elite socks, with numbers on the front and back and right leg of the shorts and AYSO/FOX LOGO. See opposite.

The uniforms are provided by Score Sports (<a href="http://scoresports.com/">http://scoresports.com/</a>), visit the website for information on uniform sizing (scroll to bottom of page, under Information). All coaches are to send a consolidated list of uniform sizes to S5GCoord@ayso498.org no later than 22 Apr 2016.


- Uniform numbers are 2 and up from the smallest uniform size; this is part of the pricing so specific numbers cannot be ordered.
- Numbers are on shorts, so shirts and short sizes need to match
- 4. **Tournaments** A Send Off Tournament is being planned for approximately 2 weeks before the Section 5 Games Tournament. The details of this tournament are still being worked out, but there are likely to be weekday evening games, so as to avoid playing on Memorial Day weekend.
- 5. **Sponsors** Region 498 is attempting to secure a main sponsor(s) for the Section 5 Games. If we are able to secure a main sponsor each team will be required to display a banner at their team bench during all games. The banner is expected to be 8' x 2' and will be provided to each team.

In addition, teams are permitted to secure their own sponsor(s), and it is expected that a banner will be required to be displayed. These team sponsor banners are:



- To be no larger than 3' x 4' in size.
- Must not be displayed more prominently than the Main Sponsor banner.

A suggested approach to displaying sponsor banners is to attach them to a shade shelter; with the Main Sponsor banner on the front and the team sponsor banners on the sides of the shelter. See diagram for concept.



- 6. Coach eligibility The coach eligibility requirements are below and apply to both Head Coach and Assistant Coach:
  - MY2015 Volunteer registration
  - Current CDC Concussion Awareness certification
  - Appropriate Coach certification
    - U10 U10 Coach Certification
    - U12 U12 Coach Certification
    - U14 Intermediate Coach Certification
    - U16 Advanced Coach Certification
    - U19 Advanced Coach Certification

If coaches require any of the coach certifications they MUST email <a href="mailto:s5GCoord@ayso498.org">S5GCoord@ayso498.org</a>, ASAP. REMEMBER IF YOU ARE NOT CERTIFIED YOU WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO COACH.

- 7. **Team Rosters** Team Rosters from eAYSO will be provided by the Coordinator. Coaches will need the Team Roster and all the team Player Forms to check in the team.
- 8. **Friendlies** Friendly games are the responsibility of the coach to arrange. Coaches are to work with the Region Scheduler (<a href="scheduler@ayso498.org">scheduler@ayso498.org</a>) for field time, and the Region Referee Administrator (<a href="referees.atll">referees.atll</a> games MUST be notified to the Coordinator (<a href="scheduler@ayso498.org">SSGCoord@ayso498.org</a>) and approved by the Regional Commissioner.
- 9. **Training** For the duration of the Spring Season Section 5 Games teams are limited to 1 training session per week; this included Extra and Core teams. It's expected that Core teams will use their normal Spring Season sessions, however, if they have backfill players they may chose to hold a training session that includes the backfill players.
